

# Log In to Your Adobe Account

## An IT Hub Guide



If you do not have a Penn State Adobe account, go to [adobe.psu.edu](https://adobe.psu.edu) and follow the prompts. Once your account is set up, you will be able to log in.


### On a Mac:

- Open the 'Applications' folder. Look for a folder called 'Adobe Creative Cloud' and double click on the icon.

### On Windows:

- Click on the 'Start' button in the lower left hand corner and look for the 'Adobe Creative Cloud.' Click on the icon.




### To Log In:

- In the window that pops up, you will enter your Penn State email account. Do not enter a password. Hit 'Sign In.'



- You will be asked to choose an account. Select the 'Enterprise ID' option.




- You will then be asked to sign in with your Penn State Access ID. You may be asked to authenticate with DUO at this time.
